Construction begins Jan. 4 on Evans Street Bridge Project in Luzerne County

Project Funded Through American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

Dunmore – PennDOT Engineering District 4 announced that construction will begin Jan. 4 on a bridge project in Luzerne County financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

A \$1,651,364 contract was awarded to Fabcor, Inc., Jessup, Lackawanna County, for the design and replacement of a two-span bridge on Route 1054 (Evans St.), Pringle and Luzerne boroughs. A detour will be in place throughout construction. PennDOT expects this project to be completed in December 2010.

Within the six-county region of northeastern Pennsylvania, PennDOT will invest \$72 million of federal economic recovery funds on 17 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and curb ramp replacements.
