Work Completed on Bedford County Bridge Project

Contract Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

Bedford County – PennDOT District 9 announced today that the work on a project to rehabilitate two bridge structures in Bedford County that was financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) has been completed.

Work has concluded on the \$249,797 contract to rehabilitate two structures on Route 1032 over Potter Creek in Bloomfield Township and Route 2029 in Monroe Township, Bedford County. C. H. & D. Enterprises, Inc., of New Stanton, Westmoreland County, performed this work.

Within District 9's six-counties, PennDOT will invest more than \$47 million of federal economic recovery funds on 19 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and traffic signal upgrades.
