PennDOT awards Route 3033 Bridge Replacement Project in Susquehanna County

Dunmore –PennDOT Engineering District 4 today announced that it has awarded a bridge replacement project in Susquehanna County financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded a \$1.033 million contract to Fahs Construction, Group of Binghamton, NY, for the replacement of the Route 3033 Wyalusing Creek Bridge in Rush Twp., Susquehanna County. Work includes removal and replacement of the current bridge, reconstruction of the bridge approach, installation of guiderail and signage, landscaping and other miscellaneous construction.

PennDOT expects this job to begin this March and be completed in November. The detour will utilize Hugh Bunnell Rd. to Newhart Rd. to Route 706.

Within the six-county region of northeastern Pennsylvania, PennDOT will invest \$72 million of federal economic recovery funds on 23 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and curb ramp replacements.
