### **Cambria and Somerset County Bridge Rehabilitation Projects Awarded** Projects Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

**Hollidaysburg** – PennDOT District 9 today announced the award of contracts for two economic recovery projects in south central Pennsylvania that are funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

Clearwater Construction Inc., of Mercer, Mercer County was awarded a \$1,815,815 project to rehabilitate the Riverside Bridge on Route 3006 in Upper Yoder and Stony Creek Townships, Cambria County and the Tire Hill Bridge on Route 4041 in Conemaugh Township, Somerset County.

HRI, Inc. of State College, Centre County was awarded a \$1.7 million design/build project that will rehabilitate two bridges including one on Route 36 in Clearfield Township and Ashville Borough. The other bridge to be rehabilitated is a bridge on Route 56 in Scalp Level Borough. The contractor will also perform joint repairs on nine additional bridges in Cambria County.

Within District 9, PennDOT will invest approximately \$47 million of federal economic recovery funds on 21 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and signal upgrades.
