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**PENNDOT AWARDS BRIDGE  
CONTRACT IN NORTH CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA**  
*Bridges to be Repaired with ARRA Funds*

MONTOURSVILLE - PennDOT District 3 today announced the award of an economic recovery contract in north central Pennsylvania financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded a \$2,270,235 contract to Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc. from State College, Centre County, for the rehabilitation of three bridges, including one in Snyder County and two in Columbia County. The Snyder County bridge is on Route 35, a quarter-mile west of Kantz in Washington Township. The Columbia County bridges included one on Route 42 over Roaring Creek in Locust Township and Mill Road (Route 2001) over a tributary to Roaring Creek in Locust Township. The contract includes design and construction of the rehabilitation work at these structures. Construction is expected to begin in March of next year, with completion by the end of November 2010.

The remaining economic stimulus projects in north central Pennsylvania move into construction at various times over the next 12 months.

Within the nine-county north central region, PennDOT will invest \$45 million of federal economic recovery funds on transportation projects that range from resurfacings and bridge replacements to guide rail and traffic sign upgrades.
