### **PennDOT Completes Work on Economic Recovery Project to Install Median Barrier along PA 100 in Colebrookdale Township, Berks County**

**Allentown** – PennDOT District 5 announced today that work on a project to install double-faced metal median barrier along approximately one mile of PA 100 between the Montgomery County line and just south of Bause Road in Colebrookdale Township, Berks County has been completed. The project was financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

This safety improvement project also included replacing shoulder guiderail on the same section of PA 100.

M.L. Ruberton Construction Company, Inc. of Hammonton, NJ was the general contractor on the \$288,800 project.

Within the six-county District 5 region, PennDOT will invest \$141 million of federal economic recovery funds on transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and Intelligent Transportation System installations.
