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PennDOT Awards Economic Recovery Contract to Rebuild Curb Ramps in Monroe County

Allentown – PennDOT Engineering District 5 announced today the award of a transportation contract in Monroe County that is financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded Kriger Construction, Inc. of Dickson City, Lackawanna County, a \$398,940 contract to rebuild curb ramps on 39 corners in Monroe County.

This is a design-build project meaning that design and construction aspects are contracted with a single entity. Construction is expected to begin at some point this spring and finish in October.

This curb ramp reconstruction contract is part of PennDOT's multi-year, multi-million dollar program to rebuild curbs ramps throughout the commonwealth to meet the latest design standards.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, PennDOT installed more than 100,000 curb ramps between 1992 and 1995 for use by individuals with disabilities. Since that time, design standards for curb ramps have changed and most ramps must be rebuilt to conform to the latest standards.

Within the six-county District 5 region (Berks, Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton and Schuylkill counties), PennDOT will invest \$141 million of federal economic recovery funds on transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and Intelligent Transportation System installations.
