State Route 77 Resurfacing Project Awarded in Crawford County

Oil City – PennDOT District 1 awarded a \$890,635 contract to Russell Standard Corporation of Union City, Erie County, to resurface a section of State Route (SR) 77 in Blooming Valley, Crawford County. This project is being funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The project limits begin at Woodcock Township/Blooming Valley Borough line east to the Blooming Valley/Richmond Township Line. The project is expected to begin April 1, 2010, and to be completed by the end of June.

This project is one of 35 ARRA-funded projects in PennDOT's six-county District 1 region which consists of Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties.
