Bridge Replacement Project on State Route 4024, Baker Hill Road, Awarded in Mercer County

Oil City – PennDOT District 1 awarded a \$701,035 contract to Shingledecker's Welding, Inc. of Franklin, Venango County, to replace the bridge on SR 4024, Baker Hill Road, over Lawango Run in Delaware Township. This project is being funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The project involves the replacement of the bridge, reconstruction of the approach roadway pavement, guiderail, signing and pavement markings.

State Route (SR) 4024, Baker Hill Road will close from March 1, 2010, to mid-July, 2010. Winter season road closure/bridge construction is necessary due to environmental in-stream permit restrictions.

Traffic will be detoured via SR 4014, Ontiontown Road, to SR 58, to T-635, Hamburg Road, to SR 4024.

This project is one of 35 ARRA-funded projects in PennDOT's six-county District 1 region which consists of Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties.
